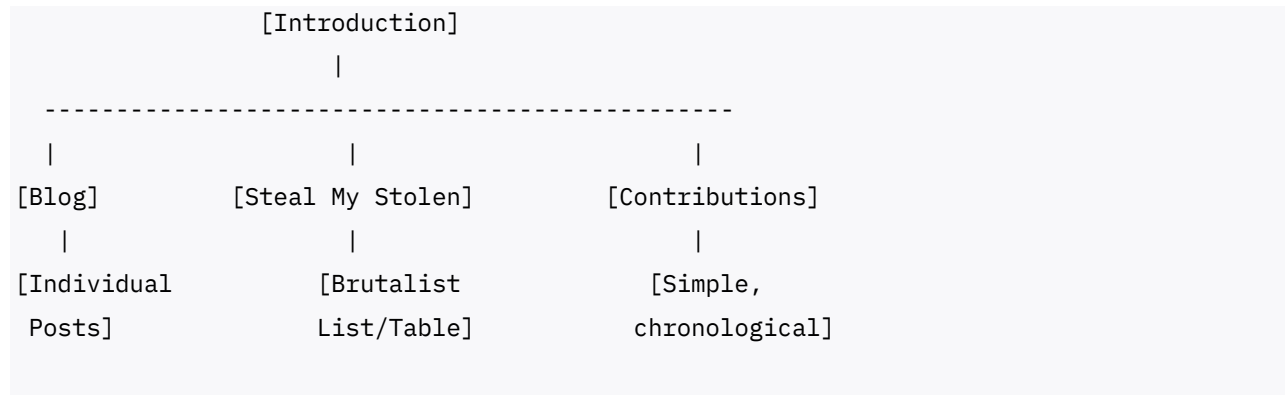

### Navigation:

- Always accessible nav: Intro | Blog | Steal | Contributions
- Each section self-contained, minimal cross-links.
- Only blog posts have a sub-page (for full post content).

### Summary of Structure & Tone:

- No “hooks,” comments, engagement pushes
